Each activity will be organized following the thematic areas and in each area you will find also specific focuses on one or more of the transversal topics.

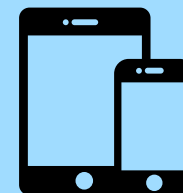

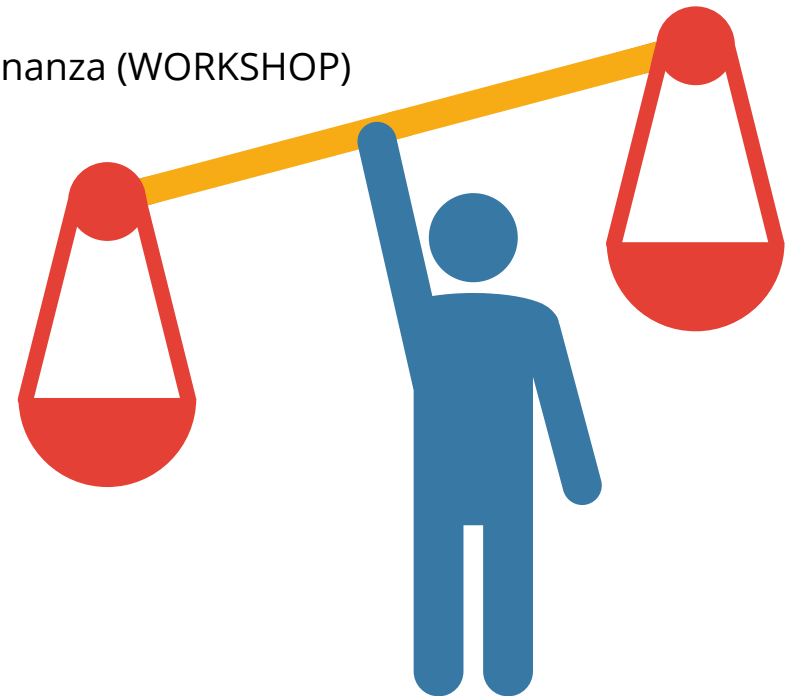
