

ADMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT – A.Y. 2026/2027

Collegio di Milano is an inter-university “**Collegio di Merito**” recognized and accredited by Italy’s Ministry of University and Research.

Founded in **2003**, Collegio di Milano is the flagship initiative of **Fondazione Collegio delle Università Milanesi**, a nonprofit organization supported by the universities of Milan and major public and private institutions in the city.

The Members of the Fondazione are: Università degli Studi di Milano, Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Università Bocconi, IULM, Università degli Studi di Milano-Bicocca, Politecnico di Milano, Università Vita-Salute San Raffaele, Humanitas University, Comune di Milano, Regione Lombardia, Assolombarda, Camera di Commercio di Milano, Aspen Institute Italia, Bracco, Edison, Intesa Sanpaolo, Mediaset and Pirelli & C.

Set in a 30,000 square meter park, the Collegio di Milano manages three residential facilities, one of which is a historic building designed by architect Marco Zanuso and two of which are newly constructed. In addition to accommodation, **Collegio di Milano offers a unique opportunity for personal, academic, and professional growth** in an international and dynamic environment, combining high-level cultural and educational activities, a wide range of quality services, and a commitment to sustainability.

Services include:

- Accommodation in a **single room with** bathroom and air conditioning
- **Meal service**, with breakfast and dinner every day and lunch on week-ends
- **Room cleaning service** with weekly bedsheet changing
- 24h opening with **reception** service and **video-surveillance**
- **Cultural and Training Activities**, complementary to the university curriculum, with the goal of providing the tools to understand the complexity of reality, experimenting with multiculturalism interdisciplinarity and internationally-minded topics, in addition to the goal of **promoting** the development of *soft skills* (e.g. teamwork, communication, leadership)
- **Tutorship** to accompany the students during their stay in the Collegio, encouraging their talents and supporting their personal and professional development
- **Career service** for assisting in understanding the professional world, and how to enter into it
- **International relations** for developing an international network of connections and identifying study and work opportunities abroad
- **Communal areas, such as:**
 - o fully equipped **gym and sports fields** (basketball, volleyball, soccer pitch in artificial turf)
 - o library, study spaces for individual and group activity open h24, auditorium
 - o **communal kitchen, dining room**, and break areas
 - o music room and art room
 - o play room
 - o living room
- **Medical assistance**
- **Wi-Fi** available in the whole campus

Admission Procedure

For the A.Y. 2026/2027, 60 spots are available for resident students (starting September 1, 2026), in addition to spots for non-resident students who wish to participate in the Cultural and Training Activities, educational services, and facilities without living on campus.

➤ *Applicant requirements*

- Be enrolled, by September 2026, in a Bachelor's, Master's, or single-cycle degree program, or in a Level I Master's program at one of the Foundation's member universities (Università degli Studi di Milano, Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Università Bocconi, IULM, Università degli Studi di Milano-Bicocca, Politecnico di Milano, Università Vita-Salute San Raffaele, Humanitas University)
- Be under 30 years of age

Students enrolled in a Second Level post-graduate Master Program (Master universitario di II livello), PhD program, Scuola di Specializzazione, students participating in an international exchange (i.e. Erasmus+) and researchers can refer to the Admissions Office (admissionsoffice@collegiodimilano.it) for further information.

➤ *Application: Deadlines and Procedure*

Applications must be submitted **online** at www.collegiodimilano.it by **July 7, 2026**. For applicants enrolling in the first year of a three-year bachelor's degree program or a single-cycle degree program – including those who have not yet completed their high school graduation exam – the deadline is extended to **July 24, 2026**.

It is necessary to complete the application and attach the following documents:

- curriculum vitae with a photo. If already obtained, please indicate the final score of your high school exit exam and three-year undergraduate program (Laurea Triennale);
- documentation relating to your school/university career:
 - For those enrolling in the 1st year of a Bachelor's Degree or Single Cycle Degree: report cards from the last two years of secondary school
 - For those enrolling in the 2nd year of a Bachelor's Degree or Single Cycle Degree: report cards from the last two years of secondary school and certificate of university exams taken with relative grades obtained and credits earned
 - For those enrolling in following years: certificate of exams taken with relative grades and credits earned and, if applicable, Bachelor's Degree certificate with grade and date of graduation
- self-presentation;
- a valid identity card or passport;
- a valid tax code (if available).

Selection Process

The following are evaluated:

- candidate's curriculum;
- requested documents;
- selection process results.

The entire selection process will take place online. The selection tests, coordinated by a team of psychologists and professors from the Fondazione Collegio delle Università Milanese, the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, and the Università degli Studi di Milano-Bicocca, are structured in four stages:

1. Evaluation of the application and of the relative documents. Screening of the candidates admitted in the following selection steps
2. Individual assessment of soft skills through filling out a questionnaire
3. English language test by the British Council (candidates who hold a valid proficiency certificate may be exempted from taking the test by uploading the document during the application process.)
4. Individual interview

It is also possible to take part in the selection process before completing the High School State exams.

The following constitute preferential consideration:

- good grades on the report cards of the last two years of high school and on the exit exam (such grades may be weighed in respect to the average grades of the school in question);
- a grade point average of at least 27/30 on completed University exams, and a curriculum of study in line with the number of CFU required by the plan of study;
- a University graduation grade higher than 100 for those who have already obtained it;
- the potential of the candidate (i.e. in respect to personal and professional development, management of university, collegiate, and extracurricular experience);
- experience in significant extra-curricular activities;
- understanding of the context and motivation to participate in the Cultural and Training Activities and life of the Collegio di Milano.

The result of the selection is expressed with a maximum score of 100, divided as follows:

- 0 to 20 points based on the evaluation of the scholastic/academic CV of the candidate and their curriculum vitae;
- 0 to 15 points based on the results of the English Test;
- 0 to 30 points based on the soft skills assessment;
- 0 to 35 points based on the individual interview.

Candidates who achieve a score equal or higher than 60/100 are eligible for admission to the Collegio di Milano.

Every candidate who has undergone the selection process will receive, via e-mail, information regarding their admission. The list of admitted students will not be published and admission is at the discretion of the Committee of Admissions, Fees and Scholarships of Fondazione Collegio delle Università Milanese.

Fees and Terms of Residency for incoming students

Collegio di Milano is open twelve months a year. The minimum stay is one semester and cannot be split into shorter periods. For the A.Y. 2026/2027, the first semester runs from September 1, 2026, to January 31, 2027, while the second semester runs from February 1 to August 31, 2027, with an optional stay during the month of August.

For the A.Y. 2026/2027 academic year, the monthly tuition fee for resident students is **€1,500.00**. For the month of August, due to the reduction in certain services, the fee is set at **€950.00** (or **€300.00** for a one-week stay).

For non-resident students, access to academic programs and use of sports facilities and study areas is subject to a monthly tuition fee of **€300.00**.

The maximum length of stay for a student is equal to the number of semesters required to complete their studies within prescribed time.

Once they have passed the selection process, admitted students must send the signed admission agreement, sign the Educational Agreement (www.collegiodimilano.it/campus-life), and pay the first month's tuition and the non-refundable insurance fee, in accordance with the procedures specified by the Student Life Office, in order to confirm their place.

If the student arrives after the semester has already begun or decides to leave Collegio di Milano before the end of the semester, they will still be required to pay the amount covering the entire semester.

The diploma from Collegio di Milano will only be awarded to students who have attended for at least two semesters, have complied with the Educational Agreement, and are up to date with their payments.

Fee reductions and Scholarships

In line with its mission, Fondazione Collegio delle Università Milanesi has always supported talent and social mobility through a robust system of financial aid. For “capable and deserving students, even if they lack financial means,” it offers financial assistance of up to €10,000.00 annually toward tuition, in addition to scholarships and special agreements funded by the Foundation's members and supporters.
